



VISITING YACHT POLICY

NOLSC will make every effort to accommodate all visitors in our limited space but sometimes that cannot be done. Therefore, it is necessary to strictly adhere to the following policies.

Visitors are required to pull up to the gas dock for check in, unless they have been given their position prior to arrival.

Unattended visiting yachts that have not signed in may be moved to a location more suitable to NOLSC as determined by club staff and are subject to a surcharge equal to 100% of the per diem fee otherwise payable for each day or part thereof in which the yacht is left unattended.

Guest privileges have been designed, so as to take into account the challenges and opportunities available to NOLSC in light of it's unique location.

Niagara-on-the-Lake Sailing Club reserves the right to prohibit entry or terminate a visitors stay whose behavior contravenes the bylaws and policies of the club, or which is harmful or injurious to the interests of the members of NOLSC.

RECIPROCITY POLICY

ONE NIGHT FREE

OPTION #1 - SAIL IN

Space that becomes available will be available on a first come first serve basis. Members of reciprocating clubs will have their first night free, subsequent nights will be at a \$1.00/ft charge. Maximum 3 nights per visit. Inside dockage in not guaran-teed at any time.

OPTION #2

RESERVATION

Reservations are prepaid, non-refundable by Visa or MasterCard at a rate of \$1.50 per foot first night; members of reciprocating clubs will have their second night free. Maximum 3 night stay per visit. Inside dockage is not guaranteed at any time.

Subject to availability of space, visitors wishing to stay more than one day, if not previously arranged, must sign in with the club staff before 10:00 am. In the interest of making the club available to as many visitors as possible it is necessary to limit the stay of boats.

The club staff may position visiting boats about the club to best suit the interests of the Niagara-on-the-Lake Sailing Club.

When leaving, visitors must sign out with the club staff before $10:00\ \mathrm{am}.$

The Niagara-on-the-Lake Sailing Club reserves the right to prohibit entry and use of the club premises to visitors whose behavior contravenes the bylaws and policies of the club, or which is harmful or injurious to the interests of the members of NOLSC.

All visitors shall be subject to all the Niagara-on-the-Lake Sailing Club's regulations and policies.

Visitors are required to dispose of their garbage into the containers placed on the premises (not in the club washrooms).

Visitors are requested to maintain the club washrooms by observing the same standards of cleanliness and good order that they observe in their own homes.

No washing of dishes and/or clothing is permitted in the Niagaraon-the-Lake Sailing Club washrooms.

Visitors are requested to assist in the energy conservation by reducing the waste of water and power.

All dogs must be on a leash. They can be exercised along the fence perimeter and everyone is requested to clean up after their own animal.
